CEAM Membership Descriptions

Full Membership (Member):

A licensed professional engineer that is a member of the Minnesota Society of Professional Engineers, Minnesota Public Works Association, or American Society of Civil Engineers, and who is a City Engineer, Chief Engineer, or Director of Public Works, serving under a proper and legal appointment.

Associate Membership (Associate Member):

A licensed professional engineering consultant who is serving as a City Engineer, Chief Engineer, Director of Public Works, or providing municipal services; or an engineer-in-training; or an Assistant City Engineer, Bureau or Section Chief in a municipal engineering or public works department and all being a member of Minnesota Society of Professional Engineers, Minnesota Public Works Association, or American Society of Civil Engineers

A former member of the CEAM who is a member of Minnesota Society of Professional Engineers, Minnesota Public Works Association, or American Society of Civil Engineers currently serving in any official capacity being consistent with the purpose of furthering and advancing the purposes of the Association.

A licensed professional engineer who is a member of Minnesota Society of Professional Engineers, Minnesota Public Works Association, or American Society of Civil Engineers serving as a Section or Division Chief with a regional planning agency or the Metropolitan Council Environmental Services Division.
